Request either PayPal or Venmo for your \$175 non-refundable deposit for us to purchase and assign your E Learning Link. This reserves your class space. Please note: if you cancel your class with less than a 7-day notice, there will be a \$50 re-registration fee required to reserve another class space.

Provide the following information: First Name, Middle Initial, Last Name, Date of Birth, Cell Phone, and the email address you would like your link sent to.

The balance of your class tuition is due on or before your first session. Our first session will meet at our Clubhouse: 761 Walnut Knoll Lane, Suite 210, Cordova, TN 38018.

Session #1

- Complete Student Record Folder and turn in the PADI Medical Statement.
- Be fitted for your rental BCD.
- Purchase your personal snorkeling gear. All gear is not suitable for SCUBA, so please do not buy anything until after this instructional lesson. If you already have personal snorkeling equipment, please bring it with you, it will need to be inspected to make sure it meets the standards for SCUBA.
- Prepare and adjust mask & fins.
- Learn how to set up and break down gear, discuss class requirements, hand signals, equalizing techniques, and how to prepare for your pool sessions.

We understand that occasionally students may miss a session. Make up sessions are \$25 for group and \$75 for private. Additional water practice sessions for fun and practice are available for \$25 at the Millington pool. Registration and payment are required no later than 24 hours in advance and may be made by calling: 901-753-2926.

Four Open Water Training dives are required to obtain your PADI Open Water Certification Card, and they must be conducted over two days. <u>Open Water Training</u> <u>fees are not included in your tuition payment</u>. Certifying dives may be completed on an Easy Divers sponsored trip, or with PADI instructors anywhere in the world. The cost for Open Water Referral dives is set by the certifying instructor and is the sole responsibility of the student.

Local quarry dive weekends are \$325 and include: customized itinerary, pre-trip water practice session, use of SCUBA gear (BCD, regulator, tank & weights), quarry admissions, tank air fills, water, snacks, one meal, Easy Divers Staff supervision, and PADI certification card. For water temperatures below 82 degrees, a wetsuit will be required. For hygienic reasons we do not rent suits but have a full supply for sale.

Certified friends and family members who have completed a mandatory pre-trip water practice session are welcome to dive with the student on a space available basis. The strict instructor to student ratios required by PADI may limit training dives to students only. The trip fees levied all travelers cover the actual expense of the dive destination and the travel expenses of the staff members. If friends and family will be any part of our diving day, there is a graduated trip fee schedule included in the Itinerary.

Students have six months to complete their Open Water Training dives without being required to participate in additional pool practice sessions. Group sessions are \$25 and private sessions are \$75. The number of practice sessions required will depend on the individual.
