

Easy Divers Student Agreement

Easy Divers welcomes you to your PADI Open Water SCUBA course.

Registration:

- Request either a PayPal or Venmo invoice for your \$200 non-refundable deposit so we may purchase and assign your E Learning link.
- Provide the following information: First name, middle initial, last name, date of birth, cell phone, and the email address you would like your link sent to.
- Complete the online forms that were emailed to you directly from PADI.

Please note: if you cancel your course with less than a 7-day notice, there will be a \$50 re-registration fee required to reserve another class space.

Confined Water Training

Classroom Session: Our first session will be held at our Shop: 761 Walnut Knoll Lane, Suite 210, Cordova.

- Select and purchase your personal snorkeling gear from our on-site store. We will waive the \$100 class gear rental fee if you purchase your mask, snorkel, fins, boots, and anti-fog from us.
- *OR* have your personal gear inspected to make sure that it meets SCUBA gear standards and pay the class gear rental fee of \$100.
- Be fitted for your rental Buoyancy Compensator Device.
- Prepare and adjust your mask & fins.
- Learn how to set up and break down gear, discuss class requirements, hand signals, equalizing techniques, and pre class preparation for your pool sessions.
- Make the final tuition payment if it is still outstanding.

Pool Sessions: All pool sessions will be held at Millington Family YMCA located at 7725 East Navy Rd, Millington.

- Please bring a water bottle, folding camp chair, towel, swimsuit, and personal snorkeling gear.
- Complete E Learning Sections One and Two prior to the first pool session, and the rest as soon as possible.

Make Up Classes:

- We understand that occasionally students may miss a session. Make up sessions are as follows –
- Attend an already scheduled group session: \$25.
- Private water session at your convenience: \$75.
- Private session that includes classroom, Quick Review, logbook, and pool: \$125

Open Water Training:

Four Open Water Training Dives are required to obtain your PADI Open Water certification card, and they must be conducted over two days. ***Open Water Training Fees are not included in your tuition payment.*** Certifying dives may be completed on an Easy Divers sponsored trip, or with PADI Instructors anywhere in the world.

The cost for Open Water Referral dives is set by the Resort Instructor who completes the final dives. This fee is the sole responsibility of the student.

Local Quarry and Lake Dive Weekends:

Costs range from \$325 - \$425 depending on destination, distance, and whether overnight accommodation is included. Trip fees include customized itinerary, use of SCUBA gear (BCD, regulator, tank & weights), quarry admissions, tank air fills, water, snacks, one meal, Easy Divers Staff supervision, and PADI certification card. For water temperatures below 82 degrees, a wetsuit will be required. For hygienic reasons we do not rent suits but have a full supply for sale. Please get fitted and purchase your suit prior to your last pool session. Buoyancy needs will change with the addition of a wetsuit, and the weight check must be completed before the Open Water weekend.

Friends and family members who are certified divers are welcome to participate in the open water weekend. Please call our office to review your diving credentials. A pool practice session, a PADI SCUBA Review, or ReActivate class may be necessary.

The trip fees levied on all travelers cover the actual expense of the dive destination and the travel expense of the staff members. If friends and family will be any part of our diving day, please see our dedicated travel itinerary for trip fee options.

Students have six months to complete their Open Water Training dives without being required to participate in additional pool practice sessions. The number of refresher sessions required will depend on individual circumstances. Additional fees will be charged for refresher sessions.
