RESCUE DIVER COURSE

Enhance your own self rescue ability as you undertake the challenging and rewarding Rescue Diver course. This course will expand your knowledge and experience level as a diver and is the first step into a leadership role in diving. Rescue Divers learn to look beyond themselves and consider the safety and well being of other divers. Although this course is challenging, it is a rewarding way to build your confidence, gain more experience under supervision, and improve your personal diving skills. Rescue Diver training will prepare you to prevent problems and, if necessary, manage dive emergencies. Many divers say this is the best course they have ever taken. You will cover:

- Self-rescue and diver stress
- Emergency management and equipment
- Panicked diver response
- In-water rescue breathing protocols
- Egress (exits)
- Dive accident scenarios

Course fee is: \$150 for students at large, \$125 for enrolled Rescue Diver Candidates, And \$75 for Easy Divers Staff Renewals. The online E Learning link will be sent when payment is received.
- Smooth progress with the water challenges is essential, all students should have their own, BCD, weights, regulator, exposure suit, and snorkeling gear and should arrive with it neatly packed in a gear bag. Tanks will be provided.
- A weekend dive trip is required for certification.
